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## **FISCAL NOTE**

The net fiscal impact of abolishing the Department of 6 Education can not be determined at this time. The fiscal impact depends on the implementation legislation to be submitted to and 8 enacted during the Second Regular Session of the 117th Legislature.

The additional costs to develop the implementation plan can 12 be absorbed by the Department of Education utilizing existing budgeted resources.

## STATEMENT OF FACT

18 This amendment abolishes the Department of Education effective March 1, 1996. The amendment requires the Commissioner 20 of Education to present proposed legislation to accomplish the abolition to the Joint Standing Committee on Appropriations and 22 Financial Affairs and authorizes the committee to report out Session legislation to the Second Regular of the 117th 24 Legislature.
