18	COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1151, L.D. 1590, Bill, "An
20	Act to Correct an Error in the Hospital Assessment Program"
22	Amend the bill by inserting before the enacting clause the following:
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26	' Emergency preamble. Wherea s, Acts of the Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and
28	Whereas, unless this legislation is enacted as an emergency
30	measure, the State will be unable to determine gross patient service revenue limits at the levels budgeted for fiscal year
32	1995-96, which, in turn, results in the inability to fully collect the hospital assessment tax pursuant to the Maine Revised
34	Statutes, Title 36, section 2801-A during that time period; and
36	Whereas, because of this inability, the State stands to lose a substantial amount of revenue per month to the State Medicaid
38	Special Revenue account; and
40	Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts
42	create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately
44	necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore,'
46	Further amend the bill by striking out all of sections 1 to 4 and inserting in their place the following:
48	'Sec. 1. PL 1995, c. 368, Pt. W, §10, sub-§3 is repealed.'

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COMMITTEE AMENDMENT

COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "H" to H.P. 1151, L.D. 1590

2 Further amend the bill by striking out all of sections 7 and 8 and inserting in their place the following: 4

'7. Retroactivity. This Act applies retroactively to July 1, 6 1995.'

Further amend the bill by inserting at the end before the statement of fact the following:

'Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the 12 preamble, this Act takes effect when approved.'

14 Further amend the bill by inserting at end before the statement of fact the following:

FISCAL NOTE

This bill permits the Department of Human Services to establish gross patient service revenue limits that allow the department to assess the hospitals, in aggregate, at the existing budgeted revenue amounts. This authority will permit the collection of additional Other Special Revenue estimated to be \$22,700,000 in fiscal year 1995-96 and \$31,500,000 in fiscal year 1996-97.'

26 Further amend the bill by relettering or renumbering any 28 nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively.

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STATEMENT OF FACT

34 This amendment makes the bill an emergency measure. The amendment removes the provisions that do not directly pertain to 36 collecting the hospital assessment at existing budgeted levels. 38 It also repeals the provision that restricted rulemaking 38 concerning the establishment of gross patient service revenue limits.
