	2. Membership. The board consists of 9 members, to be		
2	appointed by the commission Commissioner of Agriculture, Food and Rural Resources as follows:

6	A. One person recommended by a statewide association of harness horse trainers, drivers and other persons active in the conduct of harness racing in the State;

10	B. One person representing agricultural fairs;		
12	C. Two persons representing commercial tracks in this State, provided that not more than one person per track is appointed;

16	D. Two members of the public who demonstrate knowledge and support of the harness racing industry;		
18	E. One member of the commission; and		
20	F. Two persons recommended by the statewide association of standard horse breeders and owners.

24	One-third of the initial appointments must be for a one-year term; 1/3 for a 2-year term and the final 3rd for a 3-year term. Subsequent appointments must be made for 3-year terms. Board		
26	members shall annually elect a chair from among the membership by majority vote.		
30	Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this Act takes effect when approved.
