2 **Emergency preamble.** Whereas, Acts and resolves of the
Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after
adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

6 Whereas, Androscoggin County is required to submit a budget
pursuant to Resolve 1995, chapter 44, section 4, before the 90
days expire; and

10 Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts
create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of
Maine and require the following legislation as immediately
12 necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and
safety; now, therefore, be it
