Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

Sec. 1. P&SL 1981, c. 55, §6, 2nd ¶, 2nd sentence, as amended by
4 P&SL 1981, c. 92, §3, is further amended to read:

6 At each annual election of municipal officers, beginning with the
first annual election of municipal officers after the acceptance
8 of this Act, as their terms expire, one or 2 trustees as
appropriate shall be elected by ballot from among the district's
10 customers to serve until the annual election of municipal
officers occurring 3 years thereafter and until their successors
12 are appointed or elected and qualified.

14 **Sec. 2. P&SL 1981, c. 55, §11, 3rd ¶** is repealed.

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STATEMENT OF FACT

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This bill amends the charter of the Milbridge Water District
20 to provide for the election of the district's trustees by the
district's customers. The bill also removes a provision from the
22 charter regarding restrictions on the indebtedness of the
district.
