COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1169, L.D. 1601, Bill, "An Act to Allow Physicians' Offices to Receive Discounts from Pharmaceutical Manufacturers"

Amend the bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and before the statement of fact and inserting in its place the following:

'Sec. 1. 32 MRSA 13804, sub-§5 is enacted to read:

5. Parenterally administered oncologic drug products administered at medical office sites. This subchapter does not apply to parenterally administered oncologic drug products administered at medical office sites.'

Further amend the bill by inserting at the end before the statement of fact the following:

'FISCAL NOTE

This bill may decrease the number of civil suits filed in the court system. The Judicial Department may realize some minor savings from reductions of workload and administrative costs associated with the minimal number of cases that will no longer be filed. Reductions in the collection of filing fees may decrease General Fund revenue by minor amounts.'

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STATEMENT OF FACT

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6 This amendment replaces the bill. It confines the exception
to the nondiscrimination in pharmaceutical pricing laws to
parenterally administered oncologic drug products administered at
8 medical office sites. It also adds a fiscal note to the bill.
