The requirement that the East Pittston Water District, a local unit of government, be expanded represents a state mandate pursuant to the Constitution of Maine. The additional local costs to the district of providing expanded services approximately \$63,600 for initial costs with some minor annual operating costs. The Department Environmental Protection has committed to providing full funding of the estimated initial costs from bond proceeds and other dedicated revenue sources. The ongoing operating costs have been substantially funded by an operating subsidy also provided by the department. The department's funding to the district exceeds the constitutional requirement to fund at least 90% of the additional costs of a state mandate.'

This amendment adds an emergency preamble and an emergency clause to the bill. The amendment also adds a provision to the charter of the East Pittston Water District exempting the district, in cases of well contamination, from the requirement that the district petition and obtain the approval of the Public Utilities Commission before taking water to supply the inhabitants of the district with pure water, provided the district has obtained the approval of the Department of Environmental Protection.
