8 Further amend the bill by inserting before the statement of fact the following:

'Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this Act takes effect when approved.'

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment adds an emergency preamble and an emergency 18 clause to the bill.
