2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

4 **Sec. 1. 20-A MRSA c. 432** is amended by repealing the chapter
6 headnote and enacting the following in its place:

8 **CHAPTER 432**

10 **MAINE CAREER ADVANTAGE**

12 **Sec. 2. 20-A MRSA §12731, first ¶**, as enacted by PL 1993, c.
14 392, §2, is amended to read:

16 The Maine Technical College System in cooperation with the
18 Department of Education and the Department of Labor is authorized
20 to provide comprehensive administrative and financial services to
22 the Maine ~~Youth--Apprenticeship--Program~~ Career Advantage, a
24 nonprofit corporation organized under the laws of the State of
26 Maine to provide an additional education option, through a
28 partnership between business and education, for high school
30 students and young adults to obtain classroom instruction and
32 on-the-job training that prepares them directly for
34 career-related employment or continued education. The sole
purpose of the Maine ~~Youth--Apprenticeship--Program~~ Career
Advantage, referred to in this chapter as "the program," is to
assist the Maine Technical College System, public secondary
schools and other publicly supported educational institutions in
the State in providing a combination of academic learning and
structured work-based learning at businesses in the State to
students enrolled at Maine Technical College System facilities,
public secondary schools or other publicly supported educational
institutions.

36 **Sec. 3. 20-A MRSA §12734, sub-§4**, as enacted by PL 1993, c.
38 392, §2, is amended to read:

40 **4. Officers and staff.** The officers of the board consist
42 of a chair and vice-chair, elected by the board from the board
membership for a term of one year. Officers may be elected for
one additional term. The vice-chair serves as the chair in the
absence of the chair. The board is staffed by the Maine ~~Youth~~
~~Apprenticeship-Program~~ Career Advantage staff.
