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STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment clarifies that the diagnosis and treatment of biologically-based mental illness may be performed by licensed providers, including licensed clinical social workers and clinical nurse specialists, if the provider is acting within the scope of the provider's licensure. The amendment also clarifies that payment and reimbursement for these services continues at its current level.
