	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2	Sec. 1. 13 MRSA §708-A, sub-§3, ¶B, as enacted by PL 1995, c.
4	141, §2, is amended to read:
б	B. Supervised or <u>Directly supervised and</u> controlled that portion of a professional service rendered by another person
8	that was performed negligently or in breach of any other legal duty.

12	STATEMENT OF FACT
14	This bill amends the laws governing the liability of a shareholder of a professional corporation to provide that a
16	shareholder is jointly and severally liable for claims arising from the rendering of a professional service by a professional
18	corporation if that shareholder directly supervised and controlled that portion of a professional service rendered by
20	another that was performed negligently. Current law provides only that such a shareholder have supervised or controlled that
22	portion of a professional service rendered by another that was performed negligently in order for that shareholder to be held
24	liable.
