16	to Amend the Laws Regarding the Apportionment of Costs of the
18	Mount Desert Island Regional School District among Member Towns"
10	Amend the bill by inserting after the title and before the
20	enacting clause the following:
22	' Mandate preamble. This measure requires one or more local
	units of government to expand or modify activities so as to
24	necessitate additional expenditures from local revenues but does not provide funding for at least 90% of those expenditures.
26	Pursuant to the Constitution of Maine, Article IX, Section 21,
	two thirds of all of the members elected to each House have
28	determined it necessary to enact this measure.'
30	Further amend the bill by inserting at the end before the statement of fact the following:
32	
34	'FISCAL NOTE
36	This bill requires a change in the method for apportioning
	local educational costs among the member towns of the Mount
38	Desert Island Regional School District. The additional costs of
40	this state mandate to those towns whose apportionment is
40	increased can not be determined at this time. Pursuant to the Mandate Preamble, the two-thirds vote of all members elected to
42	each House exempts the State from the constitutional requirement
	to fund 90% of the additional local costs.'
