HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 637, L.D. 1645, Bill, "An Act to Revise Certain Fish and Wildlife Laws"

Amend the amendment in Part A by striking out all of section 24.

Further amend the amendment by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively.

**FISCAL NOTE**

The elimination of the increase of the guide examination fee will reduce the additional annual General Fund revenue to be collected by the Department of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife by \$16,500. The department will be collecting a net increase of \$13,338 in General Fund revenues in fiscal year 1996-97. In fiscal years 1997-98 and 1998-99, the department will experience a net annual loss of \$669 in General Fund collections.

The change in the net revenue increase for fiscal year 1996-97 will require a lowering of the off-setting appropriation necessary to ensure that the department is appropriated funds that are at least equal to the undedicated revenues collected by the department, as required by the Constitution of Maine.


