COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1196, L.D. 1646, Bill, "An Act to Establish the Freeport Towne Square Mental Retardation Facility"

Amend the bill by striking out all of section 3.

Further amend the bill by striking out all of section 5 and inserting in its place the following:

'Sec. 5. 34-B MRSA §5405 is enacted to read:

§5405. Freeport Towne Square

1. Establishment. Freeport Towne Square is established in the Town of Freeport as a facility to care for persons with mental retardation.

2. Manager. The administrative head of Freeport Towne Square is the manager. The manager reports directly to the commissioner or the commissioner's designee.

3. Duties of the manager. The manager:

A. Is responsible for the training, education, treatment and care of all persons received into or receiving services from Freeport Towne Square;

B. Is responsible for the discharge of all persons received into Freeport Towne Square; and

2 C. Has direct supervision, management and control of the
4 grounds, buildings, property, officers and employees of
6 Freeport Towne Square, subject to the approval of the

10 Further amend the bill by relettering or renumbering any
