An Act to Increase the Number of Lobster Traps Allowed on Trawls in Hancock County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows: 2 Sec. 1. 12 MRSA §6439, as amended by PL 1985, c. 268, §5, is further amended to read: 4 §6439. Areas of limited lobster fishing 6 It shall-be is unlawful to have on any trawl more-than-3 8 lebster-traps in any of the coastal waters in the following areas: 10 West of Cape Elizabeth and east of Kittery. Westerly 1. 12 More than 3 lobster traps westerly of a line drawn from the active lighthouse at Two Lights in Cape Elizabeth to the Hue and 14 Cry Buoy, and northerly and easterly of a line running between the Kitts Rocks Whistle Buoy and the West Sister Buoy and extending westerly to the New Hampshire border, and from the West 16 Sister Buoy to the Murray Rock Buoy and thence to and through the lighthouse on Boone Island and, continuing in a straight line, to 18 the boundary of the coastal waters within the jurisdiction of this State; 20 22 2. Between Pemaquid and Robinson's Points. Between More than 3 lobster traps between the following lines: 24 Beginning at a point 48 miles true north of Α. the lighthouse on Pemaquid Point, Lincoln County; thence true 26 south through the lighthouse to a point where that line intersects the southeasterly boundary of the coastal waters 28 within the jurisdiction of the State; and 30 в. Beginning at a point 40 miles true north from the lighthouse at Robinson's Point, Isle au Haut, Knox County; 32 thence true south through the lighthouse to a point where the that line intersects the southeasterly boundary of the 34 coastal waters within the jurisdiction of the State; and 36 Off Hancock County. Within More than 10 lobster traps 3. within the following radio direction-finder LORAN C bearings: 38 Beginning at Schoodic Point, Hancock County; thence running a True compass course of 159' for approximately 16 miles to LORAN C 40 bearing of 9960-W-12349.0 and 9960-X-25693.0; thence running along a True compass course of 234' for approximately 11.4 miles, 42 through Mt. Desert Rock to LORAN to and C bearing of 44 9960-W-12456.0 and 9960-X-25695.0; thence running in a True compass course of 336' for approximately 4.2 miles to LORAN C bearing of 9960-W-12440.0 and 9960-X-25718.0; thence running in a 46 westerly direction to a point where that line intersects with the line described in subsection 2, paragraph B, if it is extended to 48 that line.
