Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

Sec. 1. 5 MRSA §1662, sub-§2, is amended to read:

Work program and allotments. To examine and recommend for approval the work program and quarterly allotments of each department and agency of the State Government, before appropriations or other funds of such the department or agency shall become available for expenditure and to recommend for approval total fiscal year allotments or the reinstatement of quarterly allotments of any department or agency of State

12 Government on the basis of the extent to which the department or agency meets specified internal financial control and reporting 14 standards;

Sec. 2. 5 MRSA §1667, first ¶, as amended by PL 1981, c. 493, \$101, is further amended to read:

18 Not later than June 1st of each year, the Governor shall 20 require the head of each department and agency of the State Government to submit to the Bureau of the Budget a work program

for the ensuing fiscal year. Such The work program shall must include all appropriations, revenues, transfers and other funds, made available to said the department or agency for its operation 24 and maintenance and for the acquisition of property, and it shall

must show the requested allotments of said those sums by quarters 26 for the entire fiscal year, or, on a total fiscal year basis in accordance with section 1662, subsection 2, classified to show 28

allotments requested for specific amounts for personal services, 30 capital expenditures and amounts for all other departmental

expenses. The Department of Mental Health and Mental Retardation shall further break down its budget to include institutional food 32 expenditures. Funds not expended for this budget item shall may

not be transferred between line categories. The Governor, with the assistance of the State Budget Officer, shall review the requested allotments with respect to the work program of each

36 department or agency and shall, if he--deems the Governor 38 determines it necessary, revise, alter or change such the

allotments before approving the same. The Governor may authorize the State Budget Officer to approve quarterly allotments not to

exceed \$500 in any account. The aggregate of such the allotments shall may not exceed the total sums made available to said the

department or agency for the fiscal year in question. The State Budget Officer shall transmit a copy of the allotments approved by the Governor to the head of the department or agency

concerned and also a copy to the State Controller. The State Controller shall thereupon authorize all expenditures to be made

48 from the sums available on the basis of such the allotments and not-otherwise.

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4	This bill makes modifications in the work program process
	that will allow the State Budget Officer to recommend that a
6	department or agency allot its appropriations or allocations on
	an annual basis, providing the department or agency meets
8	specified internal financial control and reporting standards.
	The affected department or agency would continue to prepare
10	quarterly budgets and the State Budget Officer may reinstate
	quarterly allotments if financial reporting and control has
12	materially changed in the department or agency.
