

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

3 **Sec. 1. 5 MRSA §1742, sub-§7**, as amended by PL 1989, c. 483,
4 Pt. A, §14, is further amended to read:

7 **7. Approve plans for public improvements.** To approve all
8 proposals, plans, specifications and contracts for public
9 improvements which that the State or any of its agencies hold in
10 fee or by leasehold interest and for school administrative unit
11 projects costing in excess of ~~\$100,000~~ \$300,000. The
12 commissioner shall, upon the request of a school administrative
13 unit, provide consultation for any public improvement regardless
14 of cost;

19 This bill increases the threshold amount of school
20 administrative projects to \$300,000 before approval is required
from the Department of Administrative and Financial Services
through the Bureau of General Services.
