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24	Amend the bill by inserting after the title and before the enacting clause the following:
26	'Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts of the Legislature do not
28	become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and
30	Whereas, this legislation makes funding available to municipalities to remediate landfills that are a threat to
32	municipalities to remediate landfills that are a threat to groundwater and for certain other activities related to water quality; and
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36	Whereas, funding for these projects may be needed during the upcoming spring construction season; and

COMMITTEE AMENDMENT " H to H.P. 1221, L.D. 1671

Further amend the bill in section 2 in paragraph A in subparagraph (3) in the last line (page 1, line 44 in L.D.) by 2 striking out the following: "Section 1251" and inserting in its 4 place the following: 'Sections 1251 to 1387'

- Further amend the bill by inserting after section 2 the 6 following:
- 'Sec. 3. 30-A MRSA §6006-A, sub-§3, ¶E, as enacted by PL 1989, c. 48, \S 27 and 31, is amended to read: 10
- 12 E. Facility needs, including the availability of, or likely development of, cost-effective privately owned facilities or services to meet the municipal need; and 14
- Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the 16 preamble, this Act takes effect when approved.'
- Further amend the bill by inserting at the end before the 20 statement of fact the following:

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'FISCAL NOTE

The bill expands the revolving loan fund program for 26 wastewater facilities administered by the Maine Municipal Bond Bank to allow available state funds, generated from general obligation bond proceeds, to be used as match to any projects 28 that are eligible for certain federal capitalization funds. No 30 additional state funding is required to match the federal funds available for this expansion of eligible projects.

The Department of Environmental Protection will incur some minor additional costs to oversee additional projects due to the 34 expansion of projects eligible under the revolving loan fund These costs can be absorbed within the department's 36 program. existing budgeted resources.' 38

STATEMENT OF FACT

42 This amendment clarifies that the Department of Environmental Protection, in prioritizing municipal projects for 44 financing under the revolving loan fund, must consider the availability of cost-effective private sector alternatives to 46 those municipal projects. The amendment also corrects a reference to federal law and adds an emergency preamble, an 48 emergency clause and a fiscal note to the bill.
