8	scales approved by the Department of Transportation do not exceed
	104% of the allowable weights provided by section 2355,

	This bill, in accordance with federal regulations, allows
16	vehicles traveling on the Interstate Highway System a 4%
	tolerance on gross and axle weight limits if the vehicle was
18	weighed by portable scales.
