SENATE AMENDMENT " A" to H.P. 1228, L.D. 1681, Bill, "An Act Pertaining to the Northern New England Passenger Rail Authority"

Amend the bill by striking out all of section 3.


Further amend the bill by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The original bill contained language that clarified that the Northern New England Passenger Rail Authority's rate-making authority is not "rulemaking" and is not subject to supervision by any board, commission or agency. This amendment removes that language.
