HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1240, L.D. 1700, Bill, "An Act to Allow the Removal from Public Office of Certain Elected County Officials"


Amend the bill in section 7 in that part designated "~~§371-B.~~" in subsection 2 by striking out all of the last 2 sentences (page 3, lines 33 to 40 in L.D.)

Further amend the bill in section 7 in that part designated "~~§371-B.~~" in subsection 3 in the 2nd line (page 3, line 43 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "appointed" and inserting in its place the following: 'elected'

Further amend the bill in section 7 in that part designated "~~§371-B.~~" in subsection 3 in the 3rd and 4th lines (page 3, lines 44 and 45 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "or serve as sheriff of any county in the State"

SUMMARY

This amendment removes the requirements that the Governor appoint a person from the same political party when filling a vacancy in the office of sheriff and that a person appointed to fill a vacancy in the office of sheriff satisfy certain qualifications.
