COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1241, L.D. 1701, Bill, "An Act to Reduce the Number of Legislative Confirmation Hearings"

Amend the bill by striking out all of sections 1, 3, 7, 8 and 12.

Further amend the bill by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively.

Further amend the bill by inserting at the end before the statement of fact the following:

FISCAL NOTE

By reducing the number of appointments that require legislative confirmation hearings, the Legislature will realize minor savings in advertising expenses. Additional savings of legislative per diem and expense costs may occur if hearings that would have been held during an interim between sessions are no longer required. The total savings realized can not be determined at this time.'

4 The amendment removes the Land for Maine's Future Board, the  
6 Loring Development Authority of Maine, the Marine Resources  
8 Advisory Council, the Inland Fisheries and Wildlife Advisory  
Council and the Real Estate Commission from the bill. The  
entities will continue to be subject to legislative  
confirmation. The amendment also adds a fiscal note to the bill.
