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COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "H" to H.P. 1241, L.D. 1701

STATEMENT OF FACT

The amendment removes the Land for Maine's Future Board, the 4 Loring Development Authority of Maine, the Marine Resources Advisory Council, the Inland Fisheries and Wildlife Advisory Council and the Real Estate Commission from the bill. 6 The entities will continue to be subject legislative to 8 confirmation. The amendment also adds a fiscal note to the bill.
