HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1244, L.D. 1706, Bill, "An Act to Implement the Recommendations of the Task Force on Alcoholic Beverage Sales"


Amend the bill in Part A in section 46 in the last line (page 23, line 5 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "453-E." the following: 'A licensed agent may not sell liquor for less than 8% above the Bureau of Alcoholic Beverages and Lottery Operations' price, except that a reselling agency liquor store may resell liquor for less than 8% to other agents and to on-premise licensees.'

FISCAL NOTE

The amendment may result in a reduction in the amount of General Fund revenue generated by the bill. The amounts can not be determined at this time.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment prohibits the sale of liquor for less than 8% above the Bureau of Alcoholic Beverages and Lottery Operations' price, except that a reselling agency liquor store may resell liquor for less than 8% to other agents and to on-premise licensees.
