SENATE AMENDMENT "A " to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1249, L.D. 1711, Bill, "An Act to Ensure Proper Withholding of State Income Tax"

Amend the amendment on page 2 by striking out all of the 2nd indented paragraph (page 2, lines 11 and 12 in amendment).


Further amend the amendment by striking out all of section 3.

FISCAL NOTE

This amendment, eliminating the General Fund appropriation for 2 enforcement positions within the Bureau of Taxation, will significantly reduce the amount of revenue to be generated by the change in the withholding requirements for state income taxes. The amount of additional General Fund revenue and related dedicated revenue to the Local Government Fund for state-municipal revenue sharing without these positions can not be determined at this time.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment removes the appropriation section, which provided funding for a Tax Examiner position and a Revenue Agent position.
