_	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2	Sec. 1. 12 MRSA §6536 is enacted to read:
4	§6536. Scallop diving tender license

8	1. License required. It is unlawful for a person to operate a boat as a platform for the harvesting of scallops by hand, to act as a diving tender on a boat or to possess, ship,
0	transport or sell scallops unless that person is licensed under this section, section 6535, section 6701 or section 6748.
2	
	2. Licensed activity. A person licensed under this section
4	may tend divers and operate a boat as a platform for the
	harvesting of scallops by hand and may possess, ship, transport
6	and sell scallops. A scallop diving tender license does not
	authorize the holder to harvest scallops.
8	
	3. Eligibility. A scallop diving tender license may be
0	issued only to an individual and is a resident license.
2	4. Fee. The fee for a scallop diving tender license is \$89.
1	5. Prima facie evidence. The failure of at least one
	person on board the boat operated as a platform during periods of
)	diving to harvest scallops to have a license issued under section
	6701 is prima facie evidence of a violation of this section.
	STATEMENT OF FACT
2	There currently is a license for individuals who perform as tenders in both the sea urchin and scallop fisheries. Since they
4	are in the sea urchin fishery, a surcharge is applied to the
	license. There are individuals who perform as tenders only in
5	the scallop fishery who should not be subject to the surcharge. This bill creates a license for this class of individuals.
