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properties of the Military Bureau. This amendment also requires legislative approval before any funds can be expended for any

capital repair project in excess of \$300,000.

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HOUSE AMENDMENT

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STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment allows the Department of Defense and Veterans' Services, Military Bureau to make expenditures from the Capital Repair Account without legislative approval for any capital repair project costing less than \$300,000. The bureau is prohibited from using the account for a capital repair project costing \$300,000 or more unless that expenditure is approved in advanced by the Legislature.

The amendment also requires the Military Bureau to report to the Legislature every 2 years on planned capital repair projects costing less than \$300,000.
