**Emergency preamble. Whereas,** Acts of the Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

Whereas, these improvements in the operations of the Department of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife must take effect July 1, 1996; and

Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore,

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## Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

Sec. 1. 12 MRSA §7793, sub-§1, as enacted by PL 1985, c. 579, 18 §§2 and 7, is amended to read:

Register watercraft. The commissioner shall annually register watercraft and issue certificates, licenses and permits as provided in this subchapter.

1, 1996 under this subchapter continues in force until December 31st of the 2nd calendar year after the year of issuance. A
dealer's certificate of number shall-expire expires at midnight on December 31st of the calendar year for which the certificate
was issued.
