30	'FISCAL NOTE
32	The Department of the Secretary of State will incur some minor additional costs to issue additional suspensions. These
34	costs can be absorbed within the Secretary of State's existing budgeted resources. The additional suspensions will result in
36	insignificant increases of Highway Fund revenue from the additional collection of reinstatement fees.
38	This bill may increase prosecutions for Class E crimes. If
40	a jail sentence is imposed, the additional costs to the counties are estimated to be \$83.70 per day per prisoner. These costs are
42	not reimbursed by the State. The number of prosecutions that may result in a jail sentence and the resulting costs to the county
44	jail system are expected to be insignificant.
