COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1267, L.D. 1742, Bill, "An Act to Amend the Definition of Outdoor Stadium in the Liquor Licensing Laws"

Amend the bill by striking out the title and substituting the following:

**'An Act to Amend the Liquor Licensing Laws'**

Further amend the bill by inserting after the enacting clause the following:

**'Sec. 1. 28-A MRSA §2, sub-§15, ¶D-1 is enacted to read:**

D-1. "Curling club" means any facility offering curling facilities to the public for a fee that has adequate facilities for the sale and consumption of liquor.'

Further amend the bill by inserting after section 1 the following:

**'Sec. 2. 28-A MRSA §1004, sub-§3, ¶E-1 is enacted to read:**

E-1. Curling clubs;

**Sec. 3. 28-A MRSA §1073, as amended by PL 1989, c. 244, §6, is further amended by repealing and replacing the headnote to read:**

**§1073. Indoor racquet clubs; ice skating clubs; golf club facilities; curling clubs; and bowling centers**

2           Sec. 4. 28-A MRSA §1073, sub-§1, as amended by PL 1989, c.  
244, §6, is further amended to read:

4           1. **Issuance of licenses.** The commission may issue licenses  
under this section for the sale of spirits, wine and malt liquor  
6           to be consumed on the premises to bowling centers, curling clubs,  
golf clubs, indoor ice skating clubs and indoor racquet clubs as  
8           defined in section 2, subsection 15, paragraphs B-1, D-1, G, J  
and K respectively.'

10                   Further amend the bill in section 2 in subsection 1 in the  
12           5th line (page 1, line 35 in L.D.) by inserting after the  
following: "license" the following: 'under this section'

14                   Further amend the bill by relettering or renumbering any  
16           nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read  
consecutively.

18                   Further amend the bill by inserting at the end before the  
20           statement of fact the following:

22   **FISCAL NOTE**

24                   Allowing certain outdoor baseball stadiums and curling clubs  
26           to sell wine and malt liquors will result in insignificant  
increases of General Fund revenue from increased sales and the  
28           additional collection of license fees.'

30   **STATEMENT OF FACT**

32                   This amendment does the following:

- 34                   1. Permits curling clubs to obtain licenses to sell liquor  
36           to visitors to be consumed on premises;  
38                   2. Makes a technical change in the bill;
