34	This amendment is the minority report and replaces the bill. The bill extends Medicaid coverage to children under the
36	age of 19 whose family income is below 185% of the nonfarm income poverty line. This Medicaid expansion is funded through the
38	General Fund.
40	The amendment also adds an appropriation section and an allocation section. It also adds a fiscal note to the bill.
