Further amend the bill by inserting at the end before the statement of fact the following:

FISCAL NOTE

The bill requires the Hancock County Commissioners to present the county budget to the Hancock County legislative delegation. This requirement represents a state mandate pursuant to the Constitution of Maine. The additional local costs of presenting the county budget are expected to be minor. Pursuant to the Mandate Preamble, the two-thirds vote of all members elected to each House exempts the State from the constitutional requirement to fund 90% of the additional costs.'

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment replaces the bill. The amendment shifts the responsibility for calling and scheduling the informational meeting on the Hancock County budget estimates from county commissioners to the chair of the county legislative delegation. Copies of the budget estimate must be provided for the delegation 7 days before the meeting. The amendment also clarifies the process for the apportionment of county taxes and clarifies that a copy of the final county budget must be filed with the State Auditor. Finally, the amendment adds a mandate preamble and fiscal note to the bill.
