Further amend the bill by inserting at the end before the statement of fact the following:

FISCAL NOTE

The bill establishes the Maine Center for Arts Education as 10 a public chartered school. The Task Force on the Maine School for Visual and Performing Arts has requested a General Fund 12 appropriation of \$285,000 in fiscal year 1996-97 to be used for the planning, development and recruitment costs of the proposed 14 center.

16 The additional amount of General Fund appropriations required for general operations of the school can not be determined at this time. Even though the bill states that Maine 18 students may attend the school tuition-free, the bill is not 20 specific to responsibility for tuition payments, the method to calculate tuition, the effect of facility debt service payments 22 on that tuition rate, the responsibility for room and board and other associated costs and the effective date for the first year 24 of operations.'

STATEMENT OF FACT

The amendment corrects language relating to a quorum of the 30 Board of Trustees of the Maine Center for Arts Education, clarifies a section relating to public members of the board of 32 trustees and specifies that the school may provide innovative programs to assist in the professional development of classroom 34 generalists and special education teachers as well as teachers of visual and performing arts.
