HOUSE AMENDMENT "C" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1280, L.D. 1759, Bill, "An Act to Make Supplemental Appropriations and Allocations for the Expenditures of State Government and to Change Certain Provisions of the Law Necessary to the Proper Operations of State Government for the Fiscal Years Ending June 30, 1996 and June 30, 1997"

Amend the amendment by inserting after Part LL the following:

**PART MM**

**Sec. MM-1. Appropriation.** The following funds are appropriated from the General Fund to carry out the purposes of this Part.

**1996-97**

**ADMINISTRATIVE AND FINANCIAL SERVICES, DEPARTMENT OF**

**Rainy Day Fund Program**

Unallocated (\$3,900,000)

Deappropriates funds as an adjustment to an adjustment to an appropriation in Part LL, section 1.

**Tree Growth Tax Reimbursement**

All Other \$3,900,000

Provides funds to reimburse municipalities at the 90% statutory requirement level.


Further amend the bill by relettering or renumbering any

**FISCAL NOTE**

This amendment will have no net effect on General Fund  
appropriations and revenue and a balanced budget is maintained  
for fiscal year 1995-96 and fiscal year 1996-97.

**SUMMARY**

This amendment deappropriates funds from the Rainy Day Fund  
Program and transfers them to the Tree Growth Tax Reimbursement  
Fund in order to fund tree growth tax reimbursement to the extent  
required by law.
