

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

4 **Sec. 1. 12 MRSA §6671, sub-§3-B** is enacted to read:

6 3-B. Recreational licenses. Notwithstanding any provision
8 in this section, a municipality that issues recreational
10 shellfish licenses shall provide a number of recreational
12 licenses for nonresidents equal to the number of recreational
14 licenses provided for residents.

12 **STATEMENT OF FACT**

14 This bill requires a municipality that enacts a shellfish
16 conservation ordinance to provide an equal number of resident and
nonresident recreational licenses.
