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Amend the amendment in section 2 in that part designated "§1710-P." in subsection 8 in the 2nd and 3rd lines (page 4, lines 31 and 32 in amendment) by striking out the following: "the Department of Corrections."

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This amendment removes the Department of Corrections from the group of departments required to participate in a demonstration project to develop joint strategic plans and budgets in the area of job training.


