SENATE AMENDMENT "G " to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 701, L.D. 1791, Bill, "An Act to Initiate Education Reform in Maine"

Amend the amendment in section 6 in the 11th line (page 5, line 48 in amendment) by striking out the following: "July 1, 1996" and inserting in its place the following: 'July 3, 1997'

Further amend the amendment by striking out all of section 11.


FISCAL NOTE

The amendment delays the implementation of the professional development plan and eliminates the need for the \$2,100,000 General Fund appropriation to the Department of Education in fiscal year 1996-97.

SUMMARY

The amendment delays the implementation of the professional development plan by one year to July 3, 1997. It also eliminates the General Fund appropriation.
