Further amend the bill in section 3 in that part designated "<u>\$13070-C.</u>" in subsection 1 in the 2nd line (page 1, line 14 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "<u>Director</u>" the following: '<u>, subject to review by the joint standing committee</u>
of the Legislature having jurisdiction over business and economic development matters and confirmation by the Legislature,'

Further amend the bill in section 5 in that part designated "<u>\$945-C.</u>" in subsection 2 in the last line (page 4, line 9 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "<u>Development.</u>" the following: '<u>The other 4 directors must have international</u> <u>business or professional experience.</u>'

Further amend the bill by striking out all of section 6 and 18 inserting in its place the following:

20 'Sec. 6. Appropriation. The following funds are appropriated from the General Fund to carry out the purposes of this Act.

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32 Further amend the bill by striking out all of section 9 and inserting in its place the following: 34

'Sec. 9. Effective date. Those sections of this Act that repeal the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 5, section 13063-A and Title 5, chapter 107-A take effect August 1, 1996.

Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the 40 preamble, this Act takes effect when approved, except as otherwise indicated.' 42

Further amend the bill by relettering or renumbering any 44 nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively.

Further amend the bill by inserting at the end before the 48 statement of fact the following:

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'FISCAL NOTE

4 The bill creates the Maine International Trade Center and provides it with a General Fund appropriation of \$381,116 in 6 fiscal year 1996-97. Funds totaling \$381,116 are deappropriated in the same fiscal year: \$266,533 from the Department of Economic 8 and Community Development and \$114,583 from the Maine World Trade Association.'

STATEMENT OF FACT

14 The original bill consolidates activities dealing with international trade that are currently in 3 agencies. The Governor is to appoint a Maine International Trade Director who 16 reports to the Commissioner of Economic and Community Development and is responsible for developing international trade. 18 This individual, if confirmed by the board of the newly formed Maine 20 International Trade Center, also becomes president and board member of that center and must be reconfirmed by the board as 22 president every 2 years. The center's responsibility is to provide services to citizens and industry to assist international 24 trade.

26 This amendment makes the bill emergency legislation except for the provisions that repeal the existing international trade 28 agencies. It requires that the International Trade Director be confirmed by the Legislature on initial appointment. It adds a 30 revenue-neutral appropriations section, which merely transfers existing funds to the new organization. The amendment also adds 32 a revenue-neutral fiscal note.

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
