HOUSE AMENDMENT "*A*" to S.P. 705, L.D. 1804, Bill, "An Act to Grandfather Municipal Ordinances Regulating the Spreading of Sludge"

Amend the bill by striking out the title and substituting the following:

**'An Act Governing Municipal Ordinances Regulating the Spreading of Sludge'**

Further amend the bill by striking everything after the enacting clause and before the statement of fact and inserting in its place the following:

**'Sec. 1. 38 MRSA §1310-U**, as amended by PL 1995, c. 126, §2, is further amended by inserting after the 2nd paragraph a new paragraph to read:

Municipalities may enact standards stricter than state standards regulating sewer or septic sludge as long as the requirements of section 1305 are met.'

**STATEMENT OF FACT**

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4 This amendment replaces the bill. The bill allowed certain  
6 municipalities to enact stricter standards than state standards.  
8 This amendment allows all municipalities to enact stricter  
standards regulating sewer or septic sludge as long as they  
comply with state law regarding the disposal of solid waste  
created within the municipality.
