Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

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Sec. 1. 38 MRSA §1310-U, as amended by PL 1995, c. 126, §2, is further amended by inserting at the end a new paragraph to read:

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The limits on municipal ordinances contained in this section do not apply to municipal ordinances enacted prior to September 30, 1989 that relate to the spreading of wastewater treatment plant sludge on land.

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STATEMENT OF FACT

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This bill provides that the limits on municipal authority to enact ordinances regarding solid waste facilities do not apply to municipal ordinances enacted prior to September 30, 1989 that relate to the spreading of wastewater treatment plant sludge on land.

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
