
SENATE AMENDMENT " C " to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 719, L.D. 1820, Bill, "An Act to Amend the Laws Concerning Commercial Whitewater Rafting"

Amend the amendment in section 1 in subsection 2 in the first paragraph in the 3rd line from the end (page 2, line 7 in amendment) by striking out the following: "and" and inserting in its place the following: '^'

Further amend the amendment in section 1 in subsection 2 in the first paragraph in the last line (page 2, line 9 in amendment) by inserting after the following: "paragraph G" the following: 'and the combined total allocations for that river for those 2 outfitters does not exceed 120 per day'

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment permits 2 outfitters to form an affiliated group and conduct whitewater rafting trips on an allocated river under the conditions stated in the committee amendment if the combined total allocations for that river for those 2 outfitters does not exceed 120 per day.
