Amend the resolve by striking out the title and substituting the following:
'Resolve, Authorizing the Commissioner of Administrative and
Financial Services to Sell or Lease the Interests of the State in Certain Real Estate and Personal Property Held by Various State Agencies at 5 Locations'
Further amend the resolve in section 3 by striking out all of subsection 6 (page 2, lines 9 and 10 in L.D.)
Further amend the resolve in section 7 in the 6th and 7th lines (page 2, line 52 and page 3, line 1 in L.D.) by striking
out the following: "sale of the state property." and inserting in its place the following: 'sale of state property. The amount of
proceeds in excess of \$500,000 but not more than \$1,000,000 must
be deposited in the Reserve Fund for State House Preservation and Maintenance. Any amount of proceeds in excess of \$1,000,000 must be deposited in the General Fund as undedicated revenue.'
Further amend the resolve by inserting after section 7 the
following:

Further amend the resolve by inserting at the end before the statement of fact the following:

Other Funds \$10,000
The resolve authorizes the sale or lease of 5 state properties, and authorizes the Department of Administrative and Financial Services to retain the first \$500,000 in proceeds to be
used for costs related to the sale or lease of those properties as well as for other properties that the State might choose to
market. An Other Special Revenue funds allocation of \$10,000 is provided to the Department of Administrative and Financial
Services in fiscal year 1996-97 to provide spending authority if any property is sold.
Net sales between \$500,000 and \$1,000,000 will be deposited
to the Legislature's Reserve Fund for State House Preservation and Maintenance. Net sales proceeds in excess of \$1,000,000 will
be deposited as General Fund undedicated revenue.
The dedication of the first \$1,000,000 of proceeds from the sale or lease of these properties represents a reduction of
unbudgeted General Fund revenue.'

This amendment eliminates the conveyance of the Aroostook County property and clarifies that revenues that exceed a certain amount must be deposited in either the Reserve Fund for State House Preservation and Maintenance or the General Fund, depending on the amount of excess. This amendment also adds an allocation section and a fiscal note to the resolve.
