28	necessitate additional expenditures from local revenues but does
30	not provide funding for at least 90% of those expenditures. Pursuant to the Constitution of Maine, Article IX, Section 21, two thirds of all of the members elected to each House have
32	determined it necessary to enact this measure.'
34	Further amend the bill by inserting after section 1 the following:
36	'Sec. 2. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon the
38	approval by the voters of the Town of Brownfield of the transfer of the land described in section 1 of this Act to the Town of
40	Hiram. Upon the approval of the voters, the clerk of the Town of Brownfield shall provide notice of the vote to the Secretary of
