

26 **Sec. B-1. Highway Fund salary plan; lapsed balances.**  
28 Notwithstanding any other provision of law, \$3,376,543 of the  
unencumbered balance forward from fiscal year 1994-95 in the  
30 salary plan account in the Department of Administrative and  
Financial Services lapses to the Highway Fund in fiscal year  
1995-96.

32 **Emergency clause.** In view of the emergency cited in the  
34 preamble, this Act takes effect when approved.

38 **STATEMENT OF FACT**

40 This bill does the following.

42 Part A makes supplemental allocations from the Highway Fund,  
the Federal Expenditures Fund and the Other Special Revenue funds.

44 Part B authorizes the unencumbered balance in the Highway  
Fund salary plan account from fiscal year 1994-95 to lapse to the  
46 Highway Fund.
