enacted during the Second Regular Session of the 117th Legislature to be submitted to the voters in November. The estimated cost to the Secretary of State if one to 6 referenda are enacted is \$95,000. Each additional referendum costs an additional \$7,000.

If approved by the voters, the total cost of this bond issue is estimated to be \$6,267,250 with principal payments of \$5,500,000 and interest payments of approximately \$767,250.'

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment is the majority report of the Joint Standing Committee on Appropriations and Financial Affairs. This amendment reduces the term of the bond from 20 years to 5 years, reflects that the Executive Department is responsible for administering the Public Access to Maine Waters Fund and the Land for Maine's Future Fund and makes technical corrections. The amendment also adds a fiscal note to the bill.
