SENATE AMENDMENT "A " to H.P. 1350, L.D. 1851, Bill, "An Act to Clarify the Process for Referendum Recount"

Amend the bill by striking out all of sections 1 and 2.

Further amend the bill in section 3 in that part designated "\$738." by striking out all of subsection 17.

Further amend the bill by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively.

FISCAL NOTE

The amendment eliminates transfers from the Rainy Day Fund and the unappropriated surplus of the General Fund to pay for referendum recounts.

SUMMARY

This amendment removes language in the bill that authorizes transfers from the Rainy Day Fund and the unappropriated surplus of the General Fund to fund costs of conducting a referendum recount.
