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

HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1351, L.D. 1852, Bill, "An Act to Establish the Board of Complementary Health Care Providers and to Regulate the Practice of Naturopathic Medicine"

Amend the bill in section 13 in that part designated "§12522." in subsection 1 in the 6th line (page 12, line 27 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "counseling, hypnotherapy, biofeedback."

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment deletes counseling, hypnotherapy and biofeedback from the permissible therapies that may be practiced by a naturopathic doctor.

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
