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SENATE AMENDMENT "A " to H.P. 1352, L.D. 1853, Bill, "An Act to Reorganize and Redirect Aspects of the Site Location of Development Laws"

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Amend the bill by striking out all of sections B-13, B-14 and B-16.

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Further amend the bill by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively.

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FISCAL NOTE

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Eliminating the proposed change to the threshold for review of transmission lines will reduce the annual dedicated revenue loss to the Department of Environmental Protection by \$2,000.

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STATEMENT OF FACT

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
The purpose of this amendment is to retain the current review process for transmission lines of 100 kilovolts or greater.
