Sec. 1. State authorized to refund overpayment of sales tax. Resolved: That the State, through the Department of Administrative and Financial Services, Bureau of Taxation, is authorized to refund to Bond Brothers Lumber, Inc. all money Bond Brothers Lumber, Inc. overpaid for sales tax from April 1990 through June 1992. Payment may be made in a lump sum, in 2 installments or as a credit against future sales tax due.
