22	Amend the bill by inserting at the end before the statement of fact the following:
24	'FISCAL NOTE
26	This bill increases the penalties for certain crimes from
28	Class B to Class A crimes. Sentences of more than 9 months for both Class B crimes and Class A crimes must be served in a state
30	correctional institution. Since the average length of stay for a Class A crime is 1,130 days longer than for a Class B crime, the
32	incremental increase in the average cost to the State's correctional facilities is \$93,960. Sentences of 9 months or
34	less for both Class A crimes and Class B crimes must be served in a county jail. The State provides reimbursement to the counties
36	for housing these offenders.
38	The Judicial Department may require additional General Fund appropriations to cover increased indigent defense costs related
40	to these cases where the class of crime is increased. The
42	amounts can not be estimated at this time. The collection of additional fines may also increase General Fund revenue by minor
44	amounts.'
